Day 1

Singapore – Zurich

(Meals On Board)

Troop down to Singapore Changi Airport where you will set off for **Zurich**.

If you are flying by Singapore Airlines, you will assemble at the airport on the night of day 1. However, the flight only departs after midnight.

Day 2

Zurich – Titisee – Rhine Falls – Lucerne

(Meals On Board/Original Black Forest Lunch/
Dinner)

Upon arrival in **Switzerland**, cross the German border to **Black Forest**, the largest forest in **Germany**. Then, adjourn to the tourist resort township of **Titisee**, home to Germany's largest **cuckoo clock centre** and one of Germany's most idyllic lakes. You will be pleased to learn that you can tuck in to an **original Black Forest lunch** comprising German pork knuckles, sausages and the iconic Black Forest cake. After lunch, feast your eyes on the range of cuckoo clocks before you travel to **Schaffhausen** to witness **Rhine Falls**, the largest waterfall in Western Europe. Enjoy the scenic views of mountains and serene countryside as you continue to the picturesque township of **Lucerne**.

Overnight accommodation may not be in Lucerne.

Imagine chancing upon an impressive peak the likes of the Matterhorn while taking a stroll in a charming Swiss town today, and strutting on the streets of Paris the next shopping for the finest threads, paying homage to temples of art and people-watching in cafes like a man and woman about town. This trip is the perfect proposition for those who like the best of nature and big city lights wrapped together in 1 neat package.

Day 3 Lucerne

(Breakfast)

This morning, take a walking tour to **Chapel Bridge** and the stirring **Lion Monument**, carved from a limestone cliff in memory to the Swiss guards that died defending the French King. Thereafter, you may spend your time shopping to your heart's content. Luxury brands, watches, music boxes, famous Swiss chocolates and more, there's (almost) something for everyone. You may also choose to take an optional excursion to the top of Mt Titlis at your own expense.

Day 4 Lucerne – Bern – Interlaken

(Breakfast/Swiss Combo Fondue Dinner)

Begin your trip with a scenic drive to **Bern**, the capital of Switzerland. Upon arrival, proceed to Bahnhofplatz and commence your tour of the city. Keep your eyes peeled for the 16th-century astronomical **Clock Tower**. Not to be missed is a visit to the iconic **bear pit**. Thereafter, make your journey to **Interlaken**, an integral and breathtaking attraction of the Swiss Alps. Here, you can catch gorgeous views of Jungfrau mountain in the Bernese Oberland region. Tonight, savour a **Swiss combo fondue dinner** of cheese, meat and chocolate.

Day 5 Interlaken – Zermatt

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Continue your scenic journey to the municipality of **Täsch** and board the rack rail to **Zermatt**, the famous resort town at the base of **Matterhorn**, one of the most distinctive mountains in the world due to its pyramidal shape, and the quintessential icon of the Swiss Alps.

Overnight accommodation may not be in Zermatt during ski season.

Day 6 Zermatt – Montreux – Geneva – Macon

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Today, adjourn to beautiful **Montreux**, Switzerland's modern resort city on **Lake Geneva**. Often referred to as Switzerland's cultural city, it hosts numerous noteworthy festivals and major world events, such as the Montreux Jazz Festival. A photo stop is a must at **Chillon Castle** before you head off to **Geneva**. Your 1st few stops in Geneva today will be at its most famous landmarks, namely the **harbour**, magnificent **Jet d'eau**, the highest fountain in the world, **Flower Clock** and **Reformation Wall**. True citizen of the world that you are, make stops at landmarks such as **United Nations Building** and **International Committee of the Red Cross**. Thereafter, transfer to **Macon** in **France** where you will spend the night.

Day 7

Macon – Paris

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

This morning, continue to **Paris**. Immerse in the sights of Napoleon's **Arc de Triomphe**, **Champs Elysees Boulevard** and **Place de la Concorde** on your city tour. Witness the iconic **Eiffel Tower** and celebrated **Notre Dame Cathedral**, one of the most magnificent masterpieces of Gothic architecture. Thereafter, check out **Fragonard Perfumery**, one of the largest perfumeries in France, and indeed, it also happens to be an awesome place to purchase exclusive French scents that won't break the bank.

Day 8

Paris

(Breakfast)

Today, spend the day at leisure traversing the City of Light. May we suggest that you head to the numerous cafes near the Louvre where you can order a cuppa, a crepe, and watch the world pass you by as you engage in priceless conversations with your loved ones.
