Chitose - Sapporo - Otaru -Sapporo


(Lunch/Dinner)

Next, have a time of indulgence at Ishiya Chocolate Factory; don't feel shy for succumbing to the sweet temptation this once. After that, head to Odori Park in the heart of Sapporo city. This beautifully manicured green space is a charming assembly of monumental fountains, sculptures and flowerbeds. Round off your day with retail therapy at Hokkaido's longest shopping street Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade.

Day 3

Sapporo - Lake Toya -Noboribetsu - Hakodate

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Enjoy a morning photo stop at the picturesque Lake Toya and volcanic lava dome Mt Showa. Then, you can literally "grin and bear it" as the adorable residents of Showa Shinzan Bear Ranch wave and greet you upon arrival. Photograph and feed these furry animals at your own expense. After the cuteness overload, stock up on popular local horse oil skincare products at the souvenir shop. Then, embark on a leisure drive to Goryokaku Tower in Hakodate. Learn about the history of Hakodate and admire the magnificent Goryokaku fort framed against the romantic cherry blossoms in spring and vivid crimson leaves in autumn. Thereafter, proceed to Hakodate Factory, an old red brick warehouse restored as a chic waterfront dining and shopping area. Ascend Mt Hakodate for a spectacular night view of Hakodate. This evening, enjoy your stay in an onsen resort.

Day 4

Hakodate - Aomori

(Breakfast/Lunch/Kaiseki Dinner)

After breakfast, visit Hakodate morning market, a vibrant and atmospheric spot with a plethora of stalls selling fresh seafood and all sorts of snacks. Sample and purchase the day's freshest and most mouthwatering catch at your own expense. Next, proceed to Aomori by bullet train ride. Seikan Tunnel is the world's longest undersea tunnel and links Hokkaido and

Tohoku. Upon arrival in Aomori, head to Nebuta Museum Wa Rasse, an interesting museum in a unique building covered in red metal slats that stands along Aomori's waterfront district, to see the signature giant colourful floats and cultural display. Stay overnight in an onsen resort in Aomori and relax with a therapeutic apple onsen. Note

Day 5 Aomori - Akita

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart Aomori for Akita. Learn how precious stones are mined in Mine Land Osarizawa and be sure to pay attention because you will get to bring back whatever you find in a gold panning session! Then, be enchanted by the sapphire-blue waters of Japan's deepest lake, Lake Tazawa and its scenic surroundings. Thereafter, visit the former castle town and samurai stronghold Kakunodate known for its samurai architecture and resplendent cherry blossoms in spring.

Day 6

Akita - Shonai

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Today, stop by Seitai Hoshikai to see the wooden statue of Our Lady of Akita and you might join the 2,000 people who have witnessed the shedding of tears from the statue. Next, visit Kamo Aquarium which holds the Guinness World Record for the largest number of jellyfish in its collection. The range of jellyfish and jellyfish-related souvenirs and dishes are guaranteed to delight jellyfish aficionados. If you are not a jellyfish fan, the collection of fascinating marine animals is guaranteed to delight and entertain just as much. End the day

on a relaxing note at a Japanese sake museum. Learn the secrets behind Japan's most well-known drink, sample exclusive styles and flavours before making your purchase at your own expense.

Day 7

Shonai - Tendo (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)
